



Dormitory Rules Agreement

1. Players are responsible for care and condition of rooms and will pay cost of any damage sustained during their stay.
2. Housing is not responsible for loss, theft or damage to any property that players bring.
3. All animals are prohibited.
4. No drugs, alcohol or tobacco are permitted in the dormitories.
5. No personal heating, air conditioning, or cooling apparatus is permitted in rooms.
6. All participants must abide by current University policies, District of Columbia Laws and Federal Laws.
7. Participants are responsible for proper disposal of all trash from rooms.
8. You will be issued an **Access Card** for the building AND a **key** for your room. If you lose these, the cost of replacement will be taken from your check deposit.
