



Directions to Georgetown University, Cooper Field and Batting Cages

WASHINGTON (Northwest, Bethesda) Take Wisconsin Avenue M Street and make a right. Go straight past the Key Bridge as M Street changes to Canal road (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.). After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 miles from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between the Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

WASHINGTON (Downtown Washington, DC) Take M Street until it changes to Canal Road (you will pass an EXXON gas station on the right) or the Whitehurst Freeway to the end and make a left at the EXXON station. After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 miles from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

MARYLAND - FROM THE WEST (FREDERICK, MD & WESTERN PENNSYLVANIA) Take Route 70 South to Washington, DC to Route 270 South-Washington, DC. Follow 270 to 495 South (Capital Beltway) towards Northern, Virginia. Take the George Washington Parkway. You will travel approximately eight miles. Take the Key Bridge exit. At the yield sign make a right on to the Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge make a left at the light on to M Street. Go through one stoplight as M Street changes to Canal road. (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.) After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 miles from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

MARYLAND - FROM THE NORTH (BALTIMORE, MD & PHILADELPHIA, PA & NEW YORK, NY) Take 95 South to 495 West (Capital Beltway) towards Silver Spring, MD. Stay on 495 to Northern Virginia. Take the George Washington Parkway. You will travel approximately eight miles. Take the Key Bridge exit. At the yield sign make a right on to the Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge make a left at the light on to M Street. Go through the stoplight and M Street will change to Canal Road. Go through the light as M Street changes to Canal Road. (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.) After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 mile from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between McDonough Gym Tennis Courts and Multi-Sport Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The turf and batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

MARYLAND - FROM ANNAPOLIS Take 50 West to New York Avenue to 395 South (Richmond) Left exit. From 395 take the Rosslyn, VA exit. Follow the signs to the Key Bridge. Make a right on North Lynne street and follow to the Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge make a left on to M Street. Go through one light and M Street will change into Canal Road. (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.) After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 mile from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

VIRGINIA - FROM THE SOUTH (ALEXANDRIA, VA & RICHMOND, VA) Take 395 North to the Washington Boulevard/Pentagon/Arlington Cemetery exit and follow signs to Route 50 Rosslyn, VA. Make a right on to N. Lynne drive. Go through five stoplights and over the Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge make a left at the light on to M Street. Go through one light as M Street changes to Canal road. (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.) After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 mile from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

VIRGINIA - FROM NORTHERN VIRGINIA (TYSON'S CORNER & RESTON) Take Route 66 East towards Washington, DC. Take the Key Bridge exit. Make a right on to the Key Bridge. At the end of the bridge make a left at the light on to M Street. Go through the one light as M street changes to Canal road. (You will pass an EXXON gas station on the right.) After you pass the gas station, make the first right about 1/4 mile from the station. Make the next right into the Southwest Quadrangle parking garage. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

GPS ADDRESS The GPS address to Georgetown is 3700 O Street NW Washington, DC 20057. Unfortunately this will lead you to the front gates with no vehicular access. If you find yourself at the gates please proceed to the left (if you are looking at the front gates) to Prospect St. Take a left on Prospect St. Take right on 35th St. NW. Take right on M St. Entrance to campus will be on your right. The entrance to the Southwest Parking Garage is on your left. Walk up the road between Thompson Athletic Center and Cooper Field. The entrance to Yates Field House is on the left. Proceed up the stairs to the rooftop. The batting cages are located at the top of the stairs.

From the Southwest Parking Garage, take the elevator to the 1st Floor. Kennedy Hall (registration) will be in front of you. Cooper Field (where most of camp will be held) will be adjacent to Kennedy.
